NOTICE

Western Sydney University has invited nominations for Joint Master's Research (MRes) programme at Sydney, Australia from all the disciplines of COA, COHS, COAE&T, COFS, IBM&A and COBS&H of CCSHAU, Hisar. Therefore, applications are invited from the students who are currently enrolled in first semester of their respective Masters programme at CCSHAU, Hisar. The amount of fees to be borne by the student for 1 year of their research work would be as mentioned below:

- The concerned students have to be financially viable to pay concessional fees upto 25% and Social Sciences: AUD 30,100 - minus 25% (AUD 22,580) for HAU students
- Agricultural Sciences: AUD 36,600 -- minus 25% (AUD 27,450) for HAU students
- The one year fee does not include living allowance and air fare.

The students will do their master's degree course work at CCSHAU and research work will be conducted at WSU, Sydney, Australia. At CCSHAU, Hisar, the students will pay their usual fees. Furthermore, the students of COA, COHS, COAE&T, COFS, IBM&A and COBS&H, who completes Masters degree with 85% or more and follow Western Sydney University protocols under the dual degree programme, will be awarded scholarship of \$30,000 AUD for pursuing their Ph.D. For this the students will complete 1.5 years of their course work bearing all their expenses meant for CCSHAU, Hisar and research work for the period of 1.5 years will be completed at WSU. and there will be no tuition fee at WSU

Hence, the interested students may submit their applications in the prescribed proforma to concerned Dean of the College for onward transmission to the International Affairs Cell O/o Dean, PGS office latest by 31st December, 2021. There is no fixed number of seats for below mentioned courses and all deans are requested to encourage maximum number of students to participate in this international collaborative initiative.

The Expression of Interest in the following thematic areas are to be taken from students by different colleges of our university for Master's and Ph.D. programme in WSU:

1. Agribusiness, Marketing and Technology Transfer Management (Agri Extension/Agri Marketing)

5. Climate change and Forestry (Forestry Science)

8. Agricultural Database System(Ag Economics)
9. Agri Engineering- Robotics and AI (Ag Engineering)
10. Food and Nutrition (Food and Nutrition)
