- 2. I, have been directed to invite your attention to the subject mentioned above and to state that the Government has decided the continuation of empanelment of Private Hospitals till the issuance of New Empanelment Policy. The hospitals shall follow the instructions of empanelment and that of Package/Implant rates not!fied by the State Govt. from time to time for providing treatment to the Haryana Government employees/pensioners and their dependents in the approved private hospitals. These instructions shall be applicable till the issuance of new policy. The reimbursement will be allowed on the same terms and conditions and notified package rates and implants rates as explained in the respective empanelment order.
- 3. The renewal of these Private Hospitals will be reconsidered by the Health Department when the new empanelment policy will be introduced.
- 4. The empanelment orders regarding period of empanelment (2 years) of all existing empanelled hospitals are hereby superseded.
