ORDER

Since Corona positive case has been reported within District from the area of Sector 13, Hisar & hence area between [start point house no. 89 to 109, 253 to 227 and 234 to 130 to 89, in sector 13, Hisar] are declared as Containment Zone and remaining area of Sector 13 is declared as Buffer Zone for all the purposes and objective as prescribed in the protocol of COVID-19 District Containment Plan (Health Department) to prevent its spread in the adjoining areas.

For combating the situation at hand, the following action plan is prescribed to carry out screening of the suspects, testing of all suspected cases, quarantine, isolation, social distancing and

other public health measures in the Containment Zone as well as Buffer Zone effectively:

1. At-least 2 teams comprising of Asha Workers and ANMS for conducting door to door screening/thermal scanning of each and every persons of the entire households falling in the Containment Zone shall be deployed by the Civil Surgeon Hisar and for these teams there would be one supervisors doctor for supervision & reporting. All of them would work under the strict directions of the Civil Surgeon, Hisar. All the staff on duty shall be provided with personal protective equipments and other required devices for screening/thermal scanning etc. Gates/Door Knobs of each and every household will be properly sanitized.

2. The entire areas of Containment Zone and Buffer Zone will be fully sanitized by the Municipal Corporation, Hisar. It shall be ensured by the Civil Surgeon, Hisar that the staff deployed for complete sanitization of the locality is adequately provided with personal protective equipments viz. face masks, gloves, caps, sanitizers, shoes and also follow social distancing norms. No sweeping of the area shall be done rather the solid waste shall be

picked/lifted properly to avoid dust.

3. Movement of inhabitants of Containment Zone shall be absolutely restricted and the entire Containment Zone shall be sealed by deployment of adequate police force and setting up of required number of Nakas etc. by the Superintendent of Police, Hisar. The perimeter control will ensure that there is no unchecked outward movement of population from the containment zone except for maintaining essential services. Thermal screening, IEC shall be carried out at all entry and exit points. All vehicular movement, movement of public transport and personnel movement will be stopped in containment zone and all roads including rural connecting the containment zone will be guarded by the police. For personnel and vehicles requiring movement, a pass/ID card may be issued with details recorded and communicated by SDO (C), Hisar. The Containment will be for twenty eight days.

4. SDO (C), will also post signs and create awareness informing public about the perimeter control of the containment zone. Health workers posted at the exit point will perform screening (e.g. interview travelers, measure temperature, record the place and duration of intended visit and keep complete record of intended place of stay). Details of all persons moving out of perimeter zone for essential/emergency services will be recorded and they will be followed up through IDSP. All vehicles moving out of the perimeter control will be

decontaminated with sodium hypochlorite (1%) solution.

5. That in the buffer zone no perimeter control will be observed and all commercial activities will be continued as in other normal area.

6. Necessary barricading of the Containment as well as Buffer Zone shall be done by the Superintendent Engineer, PWD (B&R), Hisar in consultation with the Police Authorities.

7. The following officers are hereby appointed as Duty Magistrates for the Containment Zone and Buffer Zone for maintenance of law and order round the clock alternatively on alternate days.

8. Sufficient stock of personal protective equipments/devices and required medicines shall be

kept at the control room by the Civil Surgeon Hisar.

9. UO, Sector 13 will be medical facilities for active and passive surveillance in containment zone. Whereas Chawla Hospital, Jewa Hospital and Holy Hospital will be passive surveillance facilities in buffer Zone. Civil Hospital will be medical facilities in the containment zone & MAMC Agroha will be Covid Hospital.

10. General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Hisar shall deploy two buses exclusively for carrying the Asha Workers/ANMs from Hospital to the Zones and drop them back as per the

requirement of the Civil Surgeon.

11. Demand of essential goods/commodities such as raw ration/milk/grocery/ medicine/ vegetables shall be worked out and lists shall be prepared by the DMEO, DFSC and Drug Control Officer, Hisar. There shall be separate packets of vegetables, ration/grocery items, milk etc. and delivery of the same would be ensured at the door step. The delivery boy would wear personal protective equipments and drop the packets at the door itself. He will not go inside of any house or make physical contact with any person.

12. The grocery items, milk, vegetables, medicine/personal protective items etc. shall be made available according to the demand, by the DFSC, Hisar, GM Milk Plant, DMEO, HSAMB, DCO and Civil Surgeon, Hisar respectively and all these items shall be kept at Community Center Sector 13, Hisar in sufficient quantity under the supervision the EO, MC Hisar.

13. Regular power supply in the Containment/Buffer Zone shall be ensured by SE, DHBVN,

14. Regular safe drinking water supply shall be ensured by the SE Public Health, Hisar.

15. Ambulances and other para medical staff shall be deployed by the Civil Surgeon, Hisar as per requirement.

16. SP, Hisar will ensure proper deployment of police force in the Containment and Buffer Zone as per the requirement and protocol.

The Sub Divisional Magistrate, Hisar shall be the Overall Incharge of the Containment/Buffer Zone. He will ensure delivery of all essential items at the door step through officers of concerned departments and oversee all the arrangements.

All the officers/officials on duty shall perform/discharge their duties efficiently and any laxity on the part of any officer/official will attract strict action under the Section 56 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.
