

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, under the directions passed by National Disaster Management Authority under Section 6(2)(i) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Union Home Secretary being the Chairperson, National Executive Council, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 10(2)(i) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 has issued order bearing No.40-3/2020-DM-(A) dated 29 June, 2020 whereby the lockdown in the Containment Zones has been extended upto 31.07.2020 and issued new guidelines as annexed therewith on unlock 2.

And, whereas as per the new guidelines referred above, under Clause 2, it has been specified that movement of individuals shall remain strictly prohibited between 10.00 PM to 5.00 AM throughout the country, except for essential activities, including operation of industrial units in multiple shifts, movement of persons and goods on National and State Highways, loading and unloading of cargo and travel of persons to their destinations after disembarking from buses, trains and airplanes.


Now, I am satisfied that the directions, in compliance of the aforementioned orders, are necessary for strictly prohibiting the movement of individuals, except for essential activities as enumerated above between 10.00 PM to 05.00 AM in the interest of maintenance of public health, hygiene and safety in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

Therefore, I, **Dr. Priyanka Soni, IAS, District Magistrate, Hisar**, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, do hereby strictly prohibit the movement of individuals between 10.00 PM to 05.00 AM, except for essential services, within the district, as well as movement outward the district with immediate effect till 31.07.2020.

The order shall be published for the information of general public and shall be promulgated within the revenue limits of district Hisar through publicity van of Public Relations Department and also by affixing copies of this order at District, Sub Divisional, Tehsil Courts, Police Stations and other public places as well.

The compliance of this order shall be strictly enforced and ensured by all Executive Magistrate/Police Officials on duty and any violation of the same shall be strictly dealt with as per sections of 188, 269 and 270 of the Indian Penal Code.
